

Assembly Instructions for: Traditional Five Lath Pot Rack Heavy Duty Six Lath Pot Rack Regency Concave Rack

Contents

4, 5 or 6 x Wooden Laths (optional).
2 x Cast Iron Rack Ends.
4 x 600mm Lengths of Steel Welded Chain.
4 x 'S' Hooks to join chain to Pot Rack/Bright Zinc Plated.
2 x Ceiling Hooks/Bright Zinc Plated.
2 x No.M8 Plastic Plugs to secure Ceiling Hooks, for use if fitted to a concrete lintel or concrete type of ceiling.
POT RACKS also include a Pack of 10 Ball End S Hooks

Fitting Instructions

Select the approximate position of where the Rack is required then determine the location of a good, solid, sound beam or ceiling joist to screw into. **NEVER** screw into plasterboard or plasterwork only, as failure will most certainly result, causing damage to ceiling and also possible personal injury. Each rack end should be positioned at least 150mm in from the end of each lath, all as per the illustration above.

Fitting into Sound Timber Joist or Beam

Drill two holes 40mm deep using a 4.5mm dia. drill, spaced the length of the lath apart less 300mm (2 x 150mm) to allow for the lath overhang, all as diagram above.

Fitting into Concrete Lintel or Ceiling

Drill two holes 40mm deep using an 8mm dia. masonry drill and fully insert the two No.M8 Plastic Plugs provided, spaced the length of the lath apart, less 300mm (2 x 150mm) to allow for the lath overhang (as diagram above).

Then screw the ceiling hooks into the holes until they are tight and the thread is **FULLY** inserted. **NO** screw thread should remain visible. It may help to use a lever or the shank of a robust screwdriver to help screw into the above correct depth and obtain the necessary securing strength required. Adjust the chains to the lengths required, fitting the 'S' Hooks onto the rack ends and the chain as illustrated in the photograph above, with the laths protruding at least **150mm** beyond the rack end fittings, exactly as detailed in the illustration above.

The whole unit is designed so that it may be easily dismantled for cleaning purposes and should **NOT** be loaded with utensils having a total combined weight of **more than 15KG**, evenly spread along the laths.

Fitting Precautions & Safety Instructions

1. Ensure that the ceiling hooks are tightly screwed **directly** into a sound joist or strong, rigid wooden beam, never solely into plaster or plasterboard.
2. Take extreme care when using step ladders and electrical power drills or hand tools.
3. Regularly check that the overall weight of the pots and pans etc. are **evenly distributed** and that they are never in danger of being accidentally dislodged or having a total combined weight of **more than 15KG**.
4. It is **essential** that the Rack is **NEVER** suspended directly above, or in the vicinity of, any gas, electric or solid fuel cooker, fire, open flame or any heat source, where a falling item can in any way ignite or cause any type of danger that could possibly result in a fire.
